

# Open Data Charter Workshops Plan

## Participants

In all three workshops, we expect (to some degree) these different participant groups

- open data noobs vs nerds
- new to the consultation vs up with the play
- different stakeholder groups — eg supply vs demand

## Desired results

### Participants

- understand what's going on (ie what is planned vs existing)
- give feedback about the implications of what's going on
- identify details that need to be looked at (even if they are not resolved)

## Process

Four main phases — each with a particular result

1. Who is here — everyone knows each other a bit and are warmed up to participation
2. What is going on — participants are up to speed with the plans for new policy
3. Your feedback — documented feedback on impacts of policy overall & some details
4. Concluding — participants know what they and the organisers have gained

## Who is here

Result — everyone knows each other a bit and are warmed up to participation

## Process

- Intro and plan
- Action infograms
  - what sector do you belong to — your name, organisation
  - how much you know about open data
  - how much you know about the plan for new open data policy

## What is going on

Result — participants are up to speed with the plans for new policy

## Process

- Presentation — questions invited (we may defer responding)
  - Intro, current state, why ODC

- Current vs proposed new policy
- Engagement process, Engagement process
- Open data ecosystem map, feedback requested
- More questions
- Optional closer look at Open Data Charter — Each group reviews a section, summarises it to the others

### **Your feedback**

Result — documented feedback on impacts of policy overall & some details.

### **Concluding**

Result — participants know what they and the organisers have gained

  - how much you have contributed — what
